

EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS

In the extremely unlikely event of an incident that might have offsite implications our offsite

Advice from the Emergency Services suggest it is best to:

GO INSIDE, STAY IN AND TUNE IN to Radio Pembrokeshire. (102.5FM) or BBC Radio Wales (93-104FM)

- If you hear the COMAH emergency siren, go indoors as quickly as possible. To hear a recording of the siren so that you will recognise it telephone **free phone 0800 0468113**
- Switch off all sources of ignition, including gas and electrical heating appliances. Block incoming draughts.
- **Do not** light matches or naked flames. **Do not** smoke.
- Choose a room facing away from our site and close the curtains.
- The emergency services and local/national radio will be working together to broadcast key information.
- Please avoid using your phone to contact Dragon – this will help us keep our lines free for emergency use.
- Wait inside until the all clear has been given by the Emergency services.
